Additional notes about PE kit

- The PE department and the school do not take responsibility for valuables. Valuables should not be brought into the PE or Games areas.
- Students unable to take part in a PE or Games lesson due to injury or illness MUST bring a note signed by a parent or carer.
- Students not taking part in a PE or Games lesson MUST still change into their PE kit as they will be expected to take some part in the lesson, e.g. coaching, refereeing or doing analysis of performance.
- Students who come to a PE or Games lesson without appropriate kit will be loaned some second hand kit *for that lesson only* by the PE department teacher. This kit will have to be returned to the member of staff at the end of the lesson and the student's parents will be informed that their child was not suitably equipped for the lesson.
- **Religious jewellery** For safety reasons, we expect all jewellery, including religious jewellery, to be removed before a PE or Games lesson. If a piece of jewellery cannot be removed for essential religious reasons, a confirmation note of this must be received by the Director of Physical Education (Mr Richardson) and the piece of jewellery must be taped up and padded for the duration of the PE / Games lesson.
