- **Internet access at home** – number of students still do not have Wifi connections and/or devices
- **Parental engagement** – concern that parents do not know how to support the school during a COVID lockdown or while their children are self-isolating
- **Exam preparation** – tuition for October exams series (A Level) and GCSE/A Level preparation for 2021
- **Literacy gaps** – access to books and whole school reading scheme
