Line, Tone, Form, Colour, Pattern, Subject Matter, Composition and Texture.
What have I done?

Try to describe how you have done your work step by step – include all key points!

Why have I done it/What have I learned?

Have you learned about a new artist? What about new skills? Why did you chose that artist etc?

What medium or materials have I used?

Paint, pencil, collage, mixed media, photography etc.

What have I done well?

Try to list at least 3 points.

What could I improve on or what would I change if I were to do it again?

Think about what went wrong and why?

What did you learn? What have you found out? What are your next steps?
