

Overview	Students arrive at WHGS with a variety of language learning experiences. In Year 7 we introduce students to Spanish speaking countries and their cultures, phonics and key language they can use to talk about themselves, their friends and their family and school. We envisage that by the end of Year 7, students will have a good understanding of the Spanish sound and spelling system, adjectival positioning and agreement, as well as a sound knowledge of key regular and irregular verbs in the present tense, introducing future tense in the summer term.
