### **Y12 Mid-Year Assessments (Monday 12 – Friday 23 January 2026)**

As part of our commitment to supporting your academic progress, we will be conducting mid-year assessments for Year 12 students during the week commencing **Monday 12 – Friday 23 January 2026** and these will take place in the classroom during timetabled lessons. Assessments for maths, the sciences and psychology have been co-ordinated as such so that students who study these subjects can all carry out the assessment at the same time. A full timetable is attached for reference.

These assessments provide an important opportunity to reflect on your learning so far, identify areas of strength, and address topics that may need further development.

#### **What you need to know:**

- **Subjects assessed:** The assessments will be based on the work covered thus far in Year 12.
- **Assessment format:** The format will vary by subject but may include written tasks, data analysis, essay-style responses, or practical problem-solving exercises.
- **Preparation:** Your teachers have guided you in lessons to help you prepare effectively. You should also use your class notes, study guides, and any revision materials provided to consolidate your understanding.

#### **How to prepare effectively:**

1. **Plan your revision:** Set aside regular time to review each subject and focus on areas where you feel less confident.
2. **Use available resources:** Practice past papers, review feedback from previous work, and make use of revision tools shared by your teachers.
3. **Look after yourself:** Maintain a balanced routine with time for rest, exercise, and healthy eating to ensure you perform at your best.

After the assessments, you will receive feedback to celebrate your successes and provide guidance on how to improve further.
