Overview	In Year 8, students build upon language and grammatical skills acquired in Year 7. Our learners continue to develop their ability in both productive skills to talk about their holiday experiences, free time and school and develop their receptive skills to understand information about others. They work on a variety of verb forms and attempt the near future tense for the first time in the holiday topic as well as recapping the conditional tense. The past tense is also introduced in the autumn term. The simple future is taught towards the end of the year in the future plans topic.
