

Year 13 Mock Exams

Examination success only comes as a result of thorough preparation and revision.

- It is important you attend all your mock exams. Failure to attend will result in a U grade/FAIL
- Arrive at the Sports Hall 10mins before the exam start time MORNING EXAMS start promptly at 8.45am
 AFTERNOON EXAMS start promptly at 1.30pm
- Avoid making appointments during this mock window, where possible.
- Subject teachers have been sharing revision resources and ideas during lessons.
- When you are not in an exam, you must go to your normal timetabled lesson
- Leave all your belongings in the FLEXIBLE LEARNING AREA
- Go to the toilet before coming to the exam room.
- Students who have access arrangements (e.g. extra time, use of a laptop etc.) for external exams will have the same arrangement in these mock exams.
- We have a facility to store your mobile phone, watches, any devices etc when you hand in your personal belongings, you will receive a ticket. You must produce the ticket to collect your things at the end of the exam.
- Students must be silent in the exam room, face the front when seated and must not communicate with other students in any way.
- We will be running the internal exams the same as the external exams. All instances of malpractice will be dealt with by SLT – parents/carers will be informed too.
- Be fully prepared and have the correct equipment to sit your exam: Basic requirements: 2 black pens, 2 pencils, compass, protractor, ruler, eraser, highlighter and calculator in a clear plastic bag or pencil case.
- Water bottles are allowed, preferably in a spill-proof cap. No labels are allowed.
