<p><b><u>Week 2: Negative prefix words</u></b></p> <p><b>Spelling tip!</b></p> <p>Add the prefix in- to the root word. However, there are some exceptions to the rule.</p> <p>For root words beginning with the letter 'l', the prefix 'in' becomes 'il-'.</p> <p>For root words beginning with the letter 'r', the prefix 'in' becomes 'ir-'.</p> <p>For root words beginning with the letter 'm' or 'p', the prefix 'in' becomes 'im-'.</p>	<p>Irregular</p> <p>Impossible</p> <p>Injustice</p> <p>Irresponsible</p> <p>Inadequate</p> <p>Immoral</p> <p>Inefficient</p> <p>Illegal</p> <p>Incomplete</p> <p>Imperfect</p>
<p><b><u>Week 3: Double consonant words</u></b></p> <p><b>Spelling tip!</b></p> <p>Remember the 1:1:1 rule. If the root word is one syllable and ends with one vowel then one consonant, the final consonant is doubled when a suffix is added.</p> <p>However, there are some exceptions. Some words with more than one syllable also have a double consonant, like controlled.</p> <p>Not all of these words have a double consonant. You must follow the rule to work out if it does or doesn't.</p>	<p>Grabbed</p> <p>Showing</p> <p>Stopped</p> <p>Tapped</p> <p>Helping</p> <p>Digging</p> <p>Begging</p> <p>Stirred</p> <p>Beginning</p> <p>Sobbed</p>

The i before e except after c rule only applies if the letters make an "ee" sound. This includes words like "deceive".

"Ei" is used if the letters make an "ay" sound. However, there are many exceptions to these rules.
