Ensure your chosen Theme is planned thoroughly. ■ Try recording yourself as you revise. Make sure you can speak for at least the minimum number of minutes* for this crucial part of the examination. ■ Don't forget to ask a question in this part of the examination. 	Assessment

Your teacher will provide you with sample questions. ■ Practise writing stock phrases that you will be able to manipulate for each theme. ■ Ensure you can include PAST, PRESENT, FUTURE tenses, justifications and opinions as well as complex structures in your work. ■ Ensure you practise the correct style of question for the tier for which you are entered. ■ Practise your English into French TRANSLATION technique.
