



Overview	<p>Students will begin their final GCSE year by looking at a range of natural hazards around the world, focussing on earthquakes and tropical storms. They will build on their KS3 knowledge by looking into the complex processes causing these hazards, and look in detail at the devastating impacts these can have in very different contexts. They will also gain a more detailed appreciation of how these are managed around the world, and use their evaluative skills to assess these strategies. They will then go on to look at the changing economic world, and look more depth at how countries and their very different contexts have differing economic development. They will also gain more understanding of how strategies such as aid and fairtrade aim to reduce the development gap, before applying their understanding to the UK by looking at how the UKs economy has changed over time. Students will then look at their final unit by focussing on resource management. They will look at how these are distributed & managed in the UK before focussing on water management around the world, including examples of specific schemes.</p> <p>In year 11 students will also develop their geographical skills by applying their understanding to two geographical enquiries, including an opportunity to experience first hand fieldwork. They will also apply their knowledge and understanding to a current geographical issue in the world, and form their opinion on this issue.</p>
