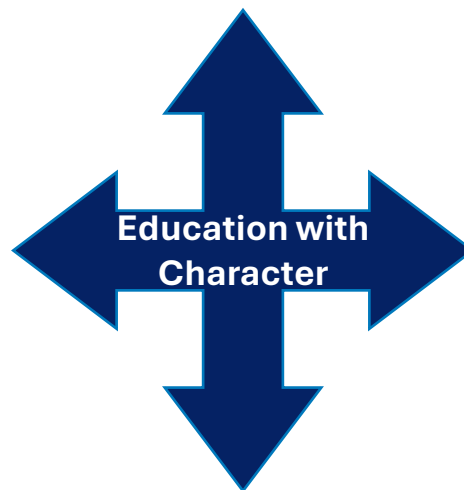
We are a **Rights Respecting School**; we embed children's human rights in our ethos and culture.
