Overview	<p>Students are introduced to a variety of experiences that explore a range of artistic and photographic media, techniques, and processes. They should be made aware of both traditional and new technologies.</p> <p>Students explore relevant images, artefacts and resources relating to a range of art, craft, and design, from the past and from recent times. Students' responses to these examples are shown through practical and critical activities that demonstrate their understanding of different styles, genres, and traditions.</p> <p>Students use sketchbooks/portfolios to underpin their work where appropriate. They may wish to develop their drawing skills to produce storyboards, thumbnail sketches and/or diagrams, where appropriate. Students use traditional methods and/or digital techniques to produce images.</p>
