Geography

Year 10



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Students begin year 10 and by building on knowledge gained in years 8 and 9 by looking at UK physical landscapes, with a focus on rivers and coastlines. They will go into more depth looking at the complex processes and influences in these areas, and look at examples around the UK. In year 10 they will also have an opportunity to look at urban landscapes around the world, with a focus on Megacities and Rio de Janiero as an example of a city in an emerging country, and assess the issues and challenges that face the population. They will also have an opportunity to apply their knowledge closer to home by studying Manchester, the issues and challenges that we face as a growing city, and assess strategies put in place to support the city. Students will then go on to learn about how ecosystems and people are interconnected, with a focus on tropical rainforests and hot deserts. They will look at key issues affecting these areas including deforestation and desertification, and use their skills to again assess strategies to prevent these issues having a lasting negative impact on these areas.
