Furthermore, it is very important you use the latest knowledge organiser (you will be given a paper copy and it will be available in your team) to use to answer your fortnightly homework quizzes in teams.

#### Year 8 Music

While you won't be completing a formal exam in music over this exam period, you will be developing your electronic advert sequences using the iMacs. Music teachers will be looking for you to focus during independent and paired iMac work, using the samples and editing tools available in Garage Band / Logic Pro X. We will be checking whether you have used appropriate samples and SFXs, developed textures and structures in your piece. Also, if you have used a musical underscore and automation. Furthermore, can you use your critical listening skills to the best of your ability in terms of answers in your progress booklets. Finally, it is very important you use the latest knowledge organiser (you will be given a paper copy and it will be available in your team) to use to answer your fortnightly homework guizzes in teams.
